### **1. Request for Proposals: Exploration of Critical Issues Emanating from Japan's March 11th Disasters (Rolling, until Sept.1 for Concept Papers)**

This new RFP will support US-Japan collaborative projects aimed at finding solutions to challenges faced by Japan following the March 11th disasters, as well as projects that will share lessons more broadly learned. Projects are eligible for up to \$100,000 per year for a maximum of 3 years of funding.
